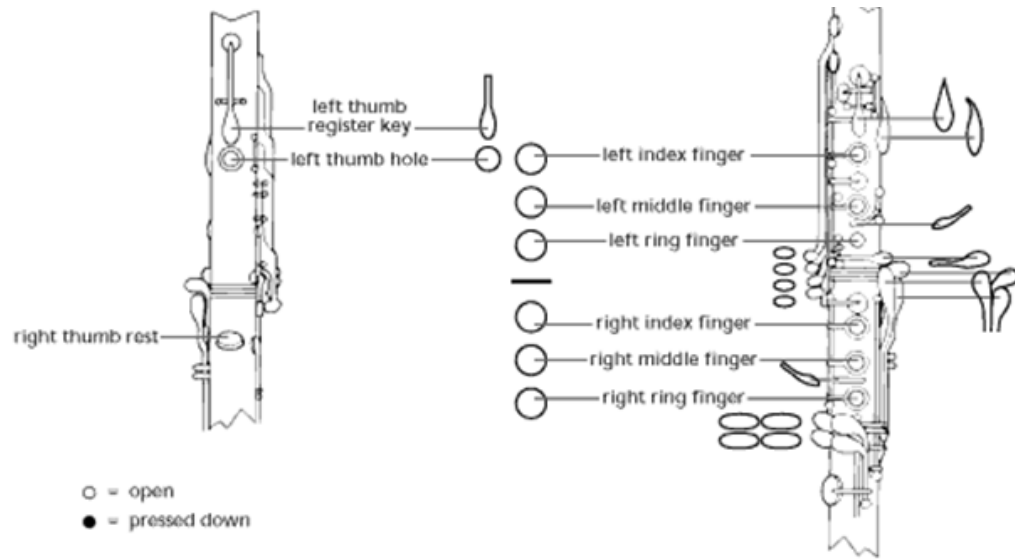


Clarinet Fingering Chart
